FAQs

What will the meal consist of?

The meal will be a drive through /take out style "hot" meal and will consist of: Pasta and choice of Meat Sauce or Vegetarian Sauce, Salad, and roll/breadstick.

What if I have family that do not live in the area, can I sell to them?

Yes. You can ask your out of town family and friends if they would like to support the troop and if they cannot come to the dinner, they can always send in a donation.

Do you take Venmo or Paypal instead of check or cash?

No, the troop is not set up to take in funds electronically, however if people want to pay in this manner some parents have used their accounts and then written out a check for the amount to the troop.

Where can I sell?

The first week of selling we would prefer you to stick to your local neighborhood and sell there. After that you can go to any other streets where you feel comfortable.

What is a venue?

The troop will be coordinating two locations where scouts can sign up to spend a few hours selling to customers outside the stores on the Saturdays and Sundays leading up to the event. We are finalizing the details now, and the signups will be coming out shortly, but the locations we are planning will be Uncle Leo's and the Redding Ridge Market who have both supported our troop in the past.

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Why have we teamed up with the Redding Road Race?

The road race has teamed up with Troop 15 & Troop 306 as well as Hoyt which will be the site of the start of the race this year. In return for our assistance during the race, they will in turn give us a portion of the race proceeds which will help to fund the campground as well as the two troops.

How can I help during the event?

We will need all hands-on deck to help out during the fundraising weekend. A sign-up genius will be sent out as we get closer to the event but here are some jobs we will be looking to fill. Volunteer times can vary from 3-5 hours.
